Memoranda of Understanding

An M.o.U was signed by the Post graduate Department of Business administration with Audacious Dreams Foundation, TamilNadu and organised a training program collaboratively with 100 Participants. The Post Graduate and research department of Commerce had signed an M.o.U with Arignar Anna Arts College, Walaja. A student exchange Program and Certificate course on Digital Marketing was organised for 90 days as part of this MOU, wherein the beneficiaries were 35 girl students, from non-commerce discipline, from both colleges. Experts from Information technology sector, Marketing and the consumers of Online marketing held discussions with students, apart from basic lectures on the topics.

Extension Activities

Various extension activities were undertaken by NCC, YRS and NSS. NSS unit of the college conducted activities such as campus cleaning, Awareness programs on COVID, Blood Donation Camps, A video presentation of Women Safety. YRC kept itself busy with yet other activities viz. Campus cleaning, and Pandemic awareness programs. The NCC organised Cycle Rally and a program depicting Jallianwala Bagh Massacre. Each of these programs were attended by more than 150 participants on an average.

The college has conducted 4 Webinars attended by around 50 participants, 4 e-Workshops wherein the beneficiaries were 700 and 1 Web Conference attended by 600 participants. Faculty members who attended Faculty Development Programs, Refresher and Short-term Courses were 53.

Higher education/ Placement/National level Exams/ Co-curricular activities

The students who had enrolled in higher studies were 204; placed were 22; those who qualified in national and international level competitive exams were 5; those who received medals for outstanding performance in sports were 23 and the ones who contributed towards cultural events and competitions were 20 in number.
