### **Computer Lab and Other Lab Facilities:**








How do you rate the relevance of the syllabus to the Industry? 62 responses




Do our students have the ability to find solutions to real life/practical problems in industry through the use of technical knowledge?








How do you rate our students in written and oral communication abilities? 61 responses








How do you rate professional capabilities of our students with respect to students from other institutions?







How do you rate the outcomes in relation to the course content? 61 responses

#### **Explication :**

The faculty reported that the syllabus framed aligned with the intended learning objectives and it adequately covered the required topics. It ensured quality education and students success. It was suitable for higher studies, the theoretical concepts matched with the application aspects, more than 50% of the teacher respondents strongly agreed and a very meager number (1.3%) of them disagreed. The responses for the program outcomes and course outcomes being specific and precise, specificity in learning outcomes, introduction of novelties in teaching-learning techniques were perceived to be perfect by the teachers as most of them strongly agreed to it. More than half of the teachers strongly agreed that Internal Assessment Tests were conducted regularly. Most of the faculty members were of the opinion that the work environment gave importance to human values, ethics and professionalism.
